The County Council is not in a position to carry out works to improve the aesthetics of an area. Weeds on roads with a speed limit of 30mph or less are treated routinely twice per year only where weeds are present and we usually spray the kerb, channel and the back of the footway (pavement) where a hard edge such as a fence or wall exists. Roads with a speed limit of 40mph or more are treated once per year only where weeds are</p>

				present, usually along the kerb and channel. The problem you have reported has been inspected and as it is not currently posing a safety issue, the site will be treated according to the programme as above and will continue to be monitored during routine inspections.
