STRAMSHALL PLAYING FIELDS – VILLAGE QUESTIONNAIRE.

Dear Residents,

As you may know, the goal posts on the playing fields were moved to the side of the pitch, while a play inspection company provided a report to the Parish Council about the safety of the location of one of the goal posts in relation to the Climbing Frame. The report confirmed that it was too close to the climbing frame and the Council decided to reinstate them, but with a smaller size pitch (5 aside).

Unfortunately, just before the July meeting, the goal posts were broken beyond repair and the Council considered this an urgent health and safety issue and removed them.

The Parish Council held an extraordinary meeting in August 2020** to discuss the goal posts, due to a question of ownership being raised by the Stramshall Village Park Committee.

At the meeting, it was resolved to post a questionnaire to all residents of Stramshall asking them the following questions:

Question 1 – The Parish Council resolved to install a 5 aside pitch, the size was decided due to health and safety, (with 7 aside goal posts). Do you want this facility?
